



Feather & Fan Afghan

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Gauge

20 sts and 26 rows worked in pattern = 4"
after blocking

Materials

Yarn: 6 Hanks of Cascade Ecological Wool (478 yards/hank)

Needles: Size US #10 (6.00mm) or size needed for gauge

Notions: stitch markers

Finished Size

52" by 72"

Abbreviations

CO = Cast On; **ST** = Stitch(es); **K** = Knit; **P** = Purl;
YO = Yarn Over; **K2tog** = Knit 2 Together.

Stitch Pattern

Row 1: K6, K across, K6.

Row 2: K6, P across, K6.

Row 3: K6, *K1, K2tog 3 times, (YO,K1) 6 times, K2tog 3 times, K1* repeat from * to * to last 6 sts, end K6.

Row 4: K6, K across, K6.

Instructions

CO 252 sts (or a multiple of 20 plus 12), placing markers after the first 6 sts, every 20 sts, and before the last 6 sts.

Knit 4 rows even, slipping markers as you come to them.

Work the stitch pattern given above until the afghan reaches the desired length. Note that the markers serve to denote the end of each pattern repeat; if you make a mistake (e.g., k2tog 4 times instead of 3), then you only have to tink 20 sts at most (and not over 200).

Knit 4 rows even and then bind off.
