**Gauge:** 4 sts = 1"

## Materials

Yarn: One skein of Cool Spun Cotton from S.R. Kertzer (1.5 oz, 73 yds)

Needles: Size US #8 or size needed to produce a pleasing fabric

**Size:** 8" by 8"

## Abbreviations

**ST** = Stitch(es); **K** = Knit; **P** = Purl; **Sl1** = Slip 1 st purlwise with the yarn in front.

## Instructions

Cast on 34 sts.

Row 1: Sl1, K

Row 2: Sl1, K

Row 3: Sl1, K2, work (K1, P1) to last 3 sts, K3

Row 4: Sl1, K2, work (K1, P1) to last 3 sts, K3

Row 5: Sl1, K2, work (K1, P1) to last 3 sts, K3

Row 6: Sl1, K2, work (K1, P1) to last 3 sts, K3

Repeat Rows 1–6 for desired length, ending after working Row 2. Bind off.
