



# Confetti Scarf

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In choosing yarn for this project, consider whether you want the fine thread that runs through the Pon Pon to contrast with your other yarn or to blend in (so that only the brightly colored flecks of the Pon Pon stand out).

**Gauge: 3.5 sts = 1" in garter stitch**

## Materials

Yarn: 1 skein Ironstone Pon Pon (335 yards)  
300 yards of any worsted or DK weight yarn in a coordinating solid — add 30 yds of solid yarn if you will add fringe or if you want to knit till the Pon Pon runs out for a longer scarf.

Needles: Size US #11 or size needed for gauge

**Size: 8" by 66"**

## Instructions

Cast on 28 sts using the solid color only. Carrying both yarns together, knit every row until the scarf reaches the desired length. Drop the Pon Pon and bind off loosely using the solid color yarn only.
