



Eyelash Scarf

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Sketched-On-A-Napkin Designs

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Materials

Yarn: 1 ball Ironstone Eyelash
1 ball coordinating sport or fingering weight yarn

Needles: Size US #17 or #19 — Size 17 will give a smaller, scarf with a slightly less open texture

Abbreviations

CO = Cast On; **ST** = Stitch(es); **K** = Knit; **BO** = Bind Off; **KFB** = Knit in Front and Back of next st to increase 1.

Instructions

CO 3 sts, carrying one strand of each yarn.

Row 1: K to end of row

Row 2: K1, KFB, K to end of row

Repeat Row 2 another 36 times. You should have 40 sts on the needle.

Row 39: K1, KFB, K to last 2 sts, KFB, K1.

Repeat Row 39 until you have approximately 4 to 5 yards of yarn remaining.

Last Row: BO 2sts; YO; BO the YO; repeat to end of row (working the yarn-over and then binding it off keeps the bound-off edge from being too tight).

Weave in yarn ends and give the scarf a good shake to release any eyelashes caught in the stitches.
