



Giant Rib Scarf

An Original Pattern for Needleworks, Inc.

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Materials

Yarn: 330 yards Imperiale S-Print (fine variegated mohair)

330 yards Kid -n- Ewe (add 60 yards of one or both yarns for fringe)

Needles: Size US #13

Size

8.5" by 66" (worked over 35 sts)

7.5" by 75" (worked over 31 sts)

Abbreviations

CO = Cast On; **ST** = Stitch(es); **K** = Knit; **P** = Purl.

Instructions

CO 35 sts (or 31 sts for narrower version, or any multiple of 4 sts plus 3 sts).

Row 1: (K3, P1) across row, ending with K3.

Row 2: K1, P1, (K3, P1) across row, ending with P1, K1.

Repeat these two rows until scarf reaches desired length. Bind off loosely.

Fringe, if you want it, can be attached to the end of each raised rib. Three strands of yarn work well.
