

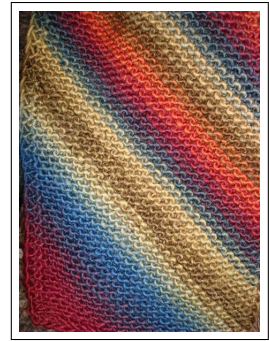


Janice's Diagonal Scarf

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An Original Pattern for Needleworks, Inc.

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Materials

Yarn: 3 Balls Mochi Plus

Needles: Size US #9 (5.5 mm) or size needed for a pleasant gauge

Size: 7" X 52"

Abbreviations

CO = Cast On; **K** = Knit; **K2tog** = Knit 2 Together; **KFB** = Knit in Front and Back of next st to increase 1 st; **P** = Purl; **P2tog** = Purl 2 Together; **PM** = Place Marker; **PSSO** = Pass the Slipped Sts Over; **RND** = Round; **RS** = Right Side; **Sl1PW** = Slip the indicated number of stitches PurlWise; **ST** = Stitch(es).

Instructions

CO 2 sts.

Sl1pw, KFB [3 sts].

Continue on every row:

Sl1pw, KFB, K to end.

When you have 41 sts (or reach the desired width (measured along the side rather than along the live sts on the needle), repeat the following two rows:

Row 1: Sl1pw, KFB, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Row 2: Sl1pw, K to end.

When you reach the desired length (measured along the longer of the two sides), decrease on every row as follows:

Sl1pw, K2tog, K to end.

When 3 sts remain:

Sl1pw, K2tog, PSSO.

Cut tail & pull through. Weave in ends.
