



Neck Doggie Scarf

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Hyphen Boy Designs

An Original Pattern for Needleworks, Inc.

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The first time I felt this furry yarn, I recalled the softness of the coat of the dog I loved as a child. Shortly after that, a dear friend lost a dog to bone cancer, and I knew I had to knit a scarf for her in this yarn to bring her that soft comfort. This pattern was the result.

Materials

Yarn: 4 skeins Plymouth Firenze (55 yards each) — only 3 skeins will make an great scarf that is just over 60"

Needles: Size US #10.5

Size: approximately 8" by 84"

Abbreviations

CO = Cast On; **ST** = Stitch(es);

Instructions

CO 24 sts.

Knit across all sts on every row.

Continue knitting until the scarf reaches the desired length.

Bind-off loosely.

Because the yarn is so furry, joining in each new ball of yarn can be accomplished by holding the ends of the old yarn and the new yarn together for 5 or 6 sts. Trying to weave in ends is rather difficult because the sts are hard to see, so overlapping the yarns is much easier.
