



# Magical\* Wizard Scarf

\*It's the Method that's Magical!

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Designs from Dove Cottage

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## Materials

Yarn: 1 skein Plymouth Encore Worsted  
**Dark Red #174**  
1 skein Plymouth Encore Worsted  
**Gold #1014**

Needles: Size US #8

## Abbreviations

**CO** = Cast On; **ST** = Stitch(es); **K** = Knit; **Sl** = Slip the indicated number of stitches (purlwise, unless otherwise noted, *e.g.* working an SSK); **WYIF** = With Yarn In Front.

## Instructions

CO 48 sts with red yarn. You may choose an invisible or provisional cast-on, but it's not necessary.

Work 20 rows (rounds) of double-knitting as follows:

(K1, Sl1 wyif) across row; turn work; (K1, Sl1 wyif) across row.

In the first half of the round, you work half of the sts. When you turn the work, you will knit the stitches that were slipped before and will slip the ones that were knitted before, thus working the other half of the sts.

Break the red yarn and work 20 rounds as above with the gold yarn.

Alternate red and gold stripes, ending with a red stripe.

### Finishing Options

Transfer the sts onto two needles, so that the knit sts are on one and the slipped sts on the other. You should have a tube of striped fabric. Take this opportunity to secure all yarn ends on the inside of the tube.

Graft the end of the tube closed with Kitchener stitch.

If you used a provisional cast-on, free the live sts and join with Kitchener as for other end.

Add alternating red and gold tassels of fringe to both ends of the scarf, with red tassels at the edges.
